SYMPTOMS OF HIV

According to HIV.gov

“About 40% to 90% of people have flu-like symptoms within 2-4 weeks after HIV infection. Other people do not feel sick at all during this stage, which is also known as acute HIV infection. Early infection is defined as HIV infection in the past six months (recent) and includes acute (very recent) infections. Flu-like symptoms can include:

1. Fever
2. Chills
3. Rash
4. Night sweats
5. Muscle aches
6. Sore throat
7. Fatigue
8. Swollen lymph nodes
9. Mouth ulcers

These symptoms can last anywhere from a few days to several weeks. During this time, HIV infection may not show up on some types of HIV tests, but people who have it are highly infectious and can spread the infection to others.”

You can get HIV if you share a needle with someone who has been infected. Many people become infected with HIV and don't know it. You must get tested to know for sure if you have the virus.

You also expose yourself to unsafe sex practices when you're high on drugs. This can also increase likelihood of getting infected with the virus and other diseases. Get tested so you can make informed decisions about your health.
